- 2) Sunday's sermon in the Book of James encouraged all believers that faith without works is dead. During the sermon, we examined the Second half of James life to learn how to practice our faith as disciples of Christ. Reflecting on what was shared do the following: In your own words explain each point, give a personal example how you are similar to James for each point, and finally give a scripture on displaying our faith for each point. (Acceptable response: James Brother of Jesus means that James is now accepted the mission of Christ and is finishing the work Christ, which was to offer the world salvation through Jesus. My example of being the brother of Jesus would be loving like Jesus loves not based on conditions, rather loving people in spite of how they love me back. Jesus calls us to love one another John 13:34-35. 34 A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. 35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples if you love one another.)
